

Dear Human Friends,

Remember Baron from our last newsletter? His foot healed and he graduated to a big bin with 20 other cats. He does not mind that they all have FIV because he tested postive for FIV



Over the past few years I noticed that most of the pregnant cats brought to the shelter are kittens themselves (less than 1 year old). This is dangerous for the mothers because their bones are still growing and the kittens in their belly use up all the nutrients, and their bones get brittle and stop growing (you humans call it osteoporosis).

How do I know this? The vet in our TNR (Trap-Neuter-Release) Clinic has come across pregnant cats who look like kittens, but are really 2-3 year olds, and have had kittens before. Please, human friends, have your female kittens (and males to prevent spraying) spayed when they are 4 - 5 months old before they get pregnant.

I hope you will come and visit us at our Summer Open House!

Coming from Michigan...take I-94 West to exit 40B and follow the above directions.






