# From the Desk of Charlie, Jr.

Dear Human Friends,

In my last letter I told you about Ian and Luke, the 2 scared cats that live in the main bathroom. The good news is that they have come out and now spend most of their time in the hallway, even exploring the Boarding and Gang areas.



On my last visit to the leukemia building I noticed a cat alone in a bin. He was curled up in a corner under the window. The sign on the door said his name was Scotch, 6 years old and "Scared". I called his name; he lifted his head. I asked him: "Why are you scared?" "I have always been scared; first of humans, and now of cats too. There are so many of them here." "How come you are here?" "My human mother died, and my human dad moved away." "How do you like it here?" "I feel safe in my bin. I trust my human caretakers. They talk to me and pet me. They even took me to the vet and got me medicine because I was so depressed that I did not eat or drink enough. They are trying to give me cat companions, but so far they only scare me." "How long have you been here?" "About 6 months."

Frisky has been with us for 6 months too. She is a 6-year old domestic shorthair, black with white toes. She is fine with people, but scared of other cats. She lives alone in a small room in Boarding, next to the offices. Her door is covered with a sheet that leaves only a small area open on the bottom. If she is exposed to another cat she will go and lie in her litter box and chew herself raw.
